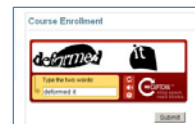
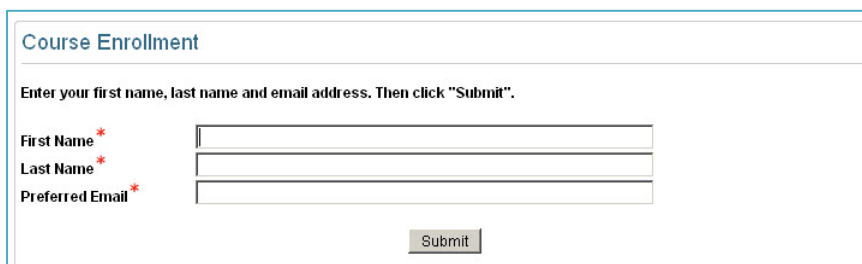


Self Enrollment Quick Reference for Online Geriatric Learning Module

1. Go to <https://www3.mdanderson.org/sakai/course/courseEnrollment.cfm?group=geriatric>
2. Enter the words exactly as they are displayed and click **“Submit.”**
3. If you are an MD Anderson workforce member with a myID username and password, select **“I am an MD Anderson employee or student.”**
Otherwise, select **“I am NOT an MD Anderson employee or student.”**
