

Clinical Site Visit Form

*Diagnostic Imaging Program
School of Health Sciences*

Each applicant seeking admittance into The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center Program in Diagnostic Imaging will be required to visit a Diagnostic Imaging Department to observe its operation for a minimum of **FOUR** clock hours.

To make a clinical site visit appointment, the applicant should follow these steps:

1. Call the Diagnostic Imaging Program Office at (713) 792-3455 in order to set up a clinical site visit and time.
2. Please honor this appointment day and time, or call to cancel or re-schedule if necessary.
3. As stated, the minimum visitation time is four clock hours. You may stay longer if you wish. Remember that the purpose of this visit is to permit you to observe a functional diagnostic imaging department and to speak with those already working in the field to hear their views about the profession. So, stay as long as you need until you are fairly sure that this is the career choice suited for you.
4. When you go for the visit, dress in a manner appropriate for a professional environment. Please do not wear blue jeans, tennis shoes or "T"-shirt type shirts. Female applicants should not wear strong perfumes or heavy make-up. Female applicants wearing skirts or dresses should keep the length below the knee. Flats are also preferred over high-heeled shoes. A **white lab coat** is required.
5. During the visitation, please remain in the area assigned by the Clinical Supervisor. If you have questions, do not hesitate to ask. Be careful, however, of asking questions while in the presence of a patient. Wait until the patient has left the area.
6. Return this form to the Program Office or the Clinical Coordinator as soon as you have completed the visit.
