³⁵	Various	22	Three patients had relapsed; others not reported. Radiation and/or chemotherapy also received.	Thirteen achieved remission, and seven (32%) survived five or more years. Less side effects from chemo/radiation; increased vitality. No side effects reported.
³⁶	Brain	78	Radiation and/or chemotherapy also received. Disease stage not reported.	Remissions at one year: Gliobl multiforme IV three of 40; medulloblastoma one of one; Ependymblastoma five of six; Astrocytoma six of eight; Mixed glioma one of one; Oligoastracytoma zero of one; Oligodendroglioma one of one; Malignant meningioma zero of two. Survival at one year: All of those in remission plus one relapsed pt with astrocytoma and one relapsed patient with oligoastrocytoma. No side effects reported.

Caution Concerning These Reports: These reports were not published in peer-reviewed journals; that is, they were not reviewed by experts in the field to determine that there was sufficient data to support the conclusions. Additional research is needed to confirm these findings.
