Located in the heart of Bellaire at 6602 Mapleridge Street, the center offers convenience, direct appointment scheduling and free parking for radiation patients in Bellaire and the surrounding area.

Everyone treated at the center receives the best combination of M. D. Anderson's wide range of cancer expertise and local care. A team of cancer experts that includes the radiation oncologist and specialists at M. D. Anderson's main campus are involved in the patient's treatment plan.

### The latest treatments, technologies

The Radiation Treatment Center in Bellaire features the latest technology and approaches to deliver the highest quality patient care possible, including a linear accelerator, computerized tomography simulation, ultrasound, three-dimensional planning, intensity modulated radiation and high-dose rate brachytherapy.

The center offers external-beam radiation, as well as partial-breast irradiation. External-beam radiation effectively treats cancer by using external high-energy beams to pinpoint and destroy cancerous cells. Over the course of five to seven days, partial-breast irradiation delivers radiation directly to the surgical lumpectomy

cavity and the specific region near the tumor site that may contain cancer cells. This technique addresses the area at highest risk of recurrence in the breast, while minimizing the dose to the rest of the breast.

## The M. D. Anderson team

Elizabeth Bloom, M.D., associate professor in the Department of Radiation Oncology, leads our team of staff members, all of whom are trained and employed by M. D. Anderson. The Bellaire care team includes radiation therapists, dosimetrists, radiation physicists, nurses, patient service coordinators and business office specialists who provide a full range of radiation oncology services and the quality of care you've come to expect from M. D. Anderson.

Dr. Bloom is board certified by the American Board of Radiology and has extensive experience in treating all adult neoplasms. To provide the highest level of patient care, she works primarily at the Radiation Treatment Center in Bellaire.

## Collaborative approach to care

The center has the capacity to treat more than 30 patients each day and is available to serve current M. D. Anderson patients, as well as others in Bellaire and the surrounding area who need radiation treatment.

By selecting the center as your place of treatment, you become a patient of M. D. Anderson's Division of Radiation Oncology while remaining under the primary care of your personal physician or referring specialist. Dr. Bloom and her staff will work directly with your physicians to tailor an individualized treatment plan to your needs, keeping them informed throughout your treatment experience.
