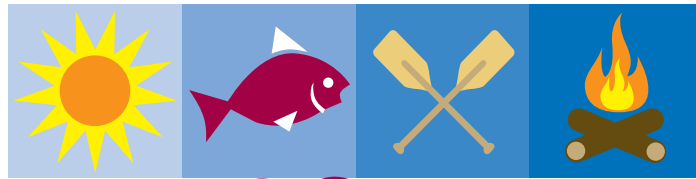


When was the last time you ate s'mores, chased lightning bugs, caught a fish or just enjoyed the relaxing beauty of the Texas Hill Country?
