

*Formalized training in clinical investigation; Exposure to laboratory research;
Apply for an ASCO YIA and design a prospective clinical trial:*

- Completion of Common Elements
- Application to ASCO/AACR Methods in Clinical Cancer Research Workshop
- 18-24 months of clinical research (2nd and 3rd years)
- Submission of funding application (e.g. ASCO YIA or ASH Clinical Investigator Grant)
- Write and submit a protocol for IRB approval
- Fellowship publication should be data-based, and/or a retrospective review with hypothesis generation, and/or the results of a clinical trial.
- Research Advisory Committee meetings every 4 months during 2nd and 3rd years.
- Strongly encouraged:
 - Continuity Clinic in Investigational Therapeutics
 - Master's Program in Clinical Investigation (Advanced Scholar Program)
 - 24 months of LBJ General Oncology Clinic)
 - Participation in at least one annual meeting (ASCO, AACR, or ASH)
