

Master Clinician Learning Objectives

Outstanding clinical skills; Broad and deep knowledge in medicine, oncology, and hematology; and Clinical effectiveness/quality improvement

- 1. Completion of Common Elements
- 2. 24 months of LBJ General Oncology Clinic
- 3. 2 months of LBJ General Oncology Consult Service (1st and 3rd years)
- 4. Minimum of 4 half-day clinics per week at MDACC after completing the 18 month required rotations
 - a. Continuity Clinics should be rotated every 6 months or less to gain broad clinical exposure
 - b. This requirement is excused during 3rd year LBJ General Oncology Consult Service
 - c. 2-4 week rotation in Cancer Prevention (excused from continuity clinic except for LBJ General Oncology Clinic)
- 5. Advisory meetings every 4 months (2nd and 3rd years)
- 6. Leadership in either Quality Improvement or Simulation activities
- 7. Fellowship publication may be a book chapter, review article or case report
- 8. Strongly encouraged:
 - a. ASCO YIA or other scholarly activity in the fall of 2nd year
 - b. Clinical exposure in surgery and/or radiation oncology
 - c. Participation in at least one annual meeting (likely ASCO)
 - d. Participation in innovative clinical programs: the International Center, Radiation Oncology, etc.
