- State-of-the-art surgery suites
- Expected integration of artificial intelligence and advanced robotics
- Art installations to inspire, comfort and promote wellness
- Seamless connection to clinical spaces in the Dan L. Duncan Building and the Lowry and Peggy Mays Clinic
