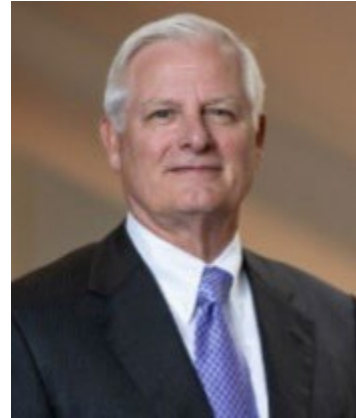


# BOARD OF VISITORS
