- Saw 187,000 patients, completed 1.7 million outpatient visits and delivered \$346 million in uncompensated care in the past fiscal year
- Home to the world's largest cancer clinical trials program
- Invested \$1.3 billion in research in the past fiscal year
- Received 188 patents and tested 27 drugs that received Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approval in the past fiscal year
