- Describe the abilities of ill children and adults to voice their perceptions about symptoms and treatment impact.
- Apply strategies to use when inviting the ill patient to give voice regarding symptoms and treatment impact.
- Recognize PRO-CTCAE™ as a validated resource for interprofessional team use when assessing and managing patient reported symptoms.
