Attend the Cancer Prevention and Control Grand Rounds (CPCGR) held on Fridays, 12pm-1pm and CPCGR Trainee Lunches, usually held at 1:15pm, the same day as CPCGR.
Complete a minimum of 8 hours of Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) training during the fellowship. Please send all attendance records of all attended Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) presentations to Vickie.
Attend other required trainee activities during this fellowship, including trainee brown bags (of other program fellows), trainee forum (scheduled twice a year), trainee expositions, as well as your departmental seminars.
R25T Postdocs take advantage of 'Writing grant seminars and tools'. Begin writing grants as soon as possible in your training appointment.
Procedures and Practices:
Cite the appropriate funding grant mechanism (this fellowship award and the MD Anderson core grant) for all publications related to the research project, during and after the fellowship.
Include the appropriate PMCID or NIHMSID number for <u>all publications</u> on your CV/Biosketch during and following the CPRTP fellowship.
Request authorization and submit justification, in writing, for all research support including books, travel, membership fees, research supplies, etc., using the instructions provided at the CPRTP orientation with Vickie Rosella.
Notify CPRTP <u>immediately</u> if you receive an additional grant award <u>during this fellowship</u> that is funded by another entity, institution, organization or the U.S. government. This includes NIDA, R25, T32, K07, NIDA, NCI, DOD, etc. <u>Trainees are not permitted to receive concurrent federal funding by more than one grant mechanism.</u>

Finishing your Cancer Prevention Training Program traineeship: Return all purchased assets to CPRTP at the conclusion of this fellowship (including laptops, monitors and other equipment) to Kava Lewis. Submit your final report and evaluation forms two weeks prior to your termination date to Vickie Rosella. Complete exit procedures accordingly with TAA/AVA, the home department of the primary mentor, and CPRTP upon conclusion of this fellowship. Supply Vickie Rosella with long term contact information.
