Alemayehu Jones obtained his Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from the American College of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine in Houston, TX and his Doctor of Traditional Chinese Medicine degree from Five Branches University in Santa Cruz, CA. He also had the privilege of spending several months at Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine in China for post-graduate studies. Dr. Jones has been nationally certified by the NCCAOM as a Diplomate of Oriental Medicine since 2014. He started his healthcare career in 2003 as a licensed physical therapist assistant, doing geriatric physical rehabilitation in skilled nursing facilities, assisted living, and home health settings. After becoming licensed as an acupuncturist, he started his own private practice in Houston, TX where he focused on a wide range of health conditions. Alemayehu later served as an acupuncturist and qigong instructor on multidisciplinary teams at the Womack Army Medical Center in Ft. Bragg, NC and the VA Medical Center in Fayetteville, AR. In 2023, he joined the Integrative Medical Center at MD Anderson in the Texas Medical Center. He is also a veteran of the US Army. During his nine years of service, he had the unique opportunity to serve on two separate humanitarian deployments to San Salvador, El Salvador and New Orleans, LA, both for hurricane relief missions.
