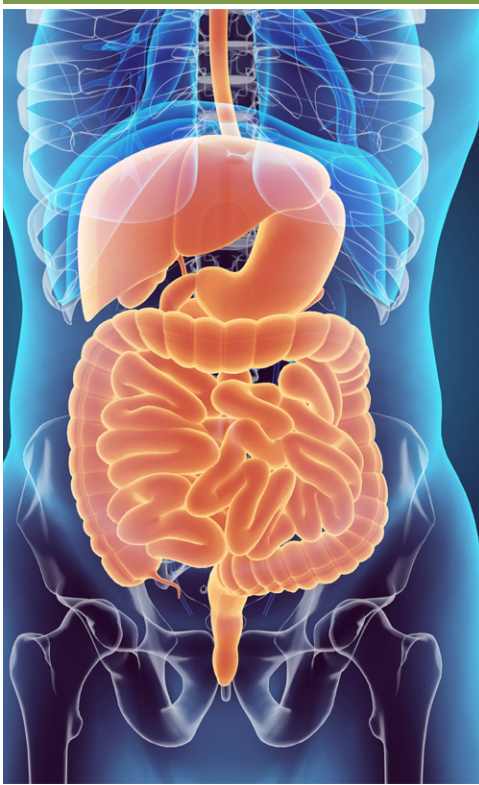


Learn and Support Group Gastrointestinal-Colorectal Center
