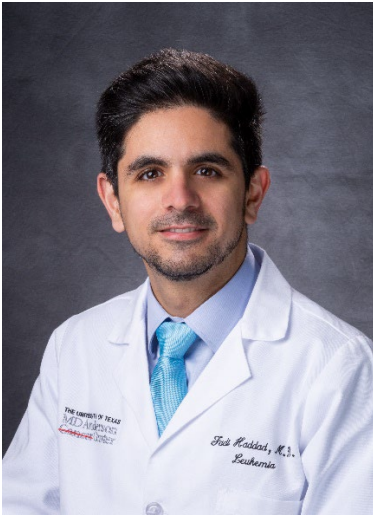

Dr. Haddad aims to enlarge his knowledge and practice in the field of Hematology by specializing in other hematological malignancies, namely lymphomas and multiple myeloma.

Dr. Haddad joined the Department of Leukemia in October 2020 as a fellow. He obtained his Degree of Doctor in Medicine from the Saint Joseph University of Beirut, Lebanon in 2016.

Dr. Haddad completed his residency training at Hotel Dieu de France University Hospital in Beirut, service as a chief resident during his residency. Prior to joining the Leukemia fellowship program, Dr. Haddad completed a fellowship in Hematology and Medical Oncology at Hotel Dieu de France University Hospital in Beirut, Lebanon in 2020. He served as a senior and chief fellow during his fellowship.
