Rodrick Babakhanlou, MD MSc is a first year Fellow in The Leukemia Fellowship Program at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center, Department of Leukemia.

Dr. Babakhanlou joined the Department of Leukemia in August 2021 as a Clinical fellow. He obtained his MD from the University of Giessen, Germany, in 2006, and his MSc with Distinction from the University of Edinburgh, Scotland, in 2015.

Dr. Babakhanlou completed his residency training both at King's College London, the University of Edinburgh, UK and the University of Sydney, Australia. He was awarded with memberships of the Royal College of Emergency Physicians and the Royal College of General Practitioners of the United Kingdom. He currently serves as the Vice-Chair of the Scientific Committee of the European Society of Emergency Medicine (EuSEM) and the Vice-Chair of the Ethics Committee of the European Society of Emergency Medicine.
