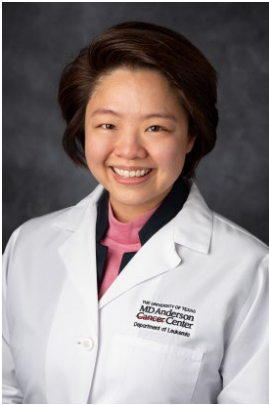

Dr. Jen hopes to establish collaborations between Singapore and the MD Anderson Cancer Center and sub-specialize in leukemia.

She obtained her Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery from the University of Oxford, United Kingdom, in 2012 with distinction. Dr. Jen received the Gibbs prize for outstanding performance in the Final Honors School of Medical Sciences in 2009, the Glaxo Scholarship for Medicine in 2010 and the Wellcome Trust Research Elective Prize in 2012.

Dr. Jen completed her residency training at the National University Hospital, Singapore, obtaining her Masters in Internal Medicine and obtaining Membership of the Royal College of Physicians (UK) during that time.

Prior to joining the Leukemia fellowship program, Dr. Jen completed a Hematology fellowship at the National University Cancer Institute, Singapore (NCIS) in 2019, upon which she joined NCIS as an attending Hematologist. She received the Best Trainee Award, Chapter of Hematology, College of Physicians, Singapore in 2020 and The Public Administration Medal (Bronze, COVID-19) from the Singapore Government in 2022.
