C. PROFESSIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS – Must be RECEIVED by March 1

_____	1. Identify three (3) professional references Identify three individuals that can provide an appropriate professional recommendation. Examples of suitable individuals include instructors, professors, employers, and supervisors. Do not submit personal references such as family, friends, and clergymen.

_____ 2. Download the recommendation form (<http://bit.ly/SHP-Rec-Form>) and distribute to your references.

Recommendations must be written on the official form. Letters, emails, etc. will not be considered.

_____ 3. Verify that Recommendation #1 has been received by the registrar's office. (check online account using procedure provided by registrar's office)

_____ 4. Verify that Recommendation #2 has been received by the registrar's office. (check online account using procedure provided by registrar's office)

_____ 5. Verify that Recommendation #3 has been received by the registrar's office. (check online account using procedure provided by registrar's office)

D. TRANSCRIPTS – Must be RECEIVED by March 1

E. CLINICAL SITE VISIT – All forms must be submitted and the clinical site visit completed by March 1



Clinical site visits may take place at MD Anderson or any site with a licensed radiation therapist. If the site visit will occur at a facility other than MD Anderson, you must obtain pre-approval.

_____	3. Send Site Visitor Profile, Site Visit Request, and Clinical Site Visit Evaluation forms to request a site visit at MD Anderson to Dr. Delores Whiteing, Clinical Site Visit Coordinator, djwhiteing@mdanderson.org
_____	4. Attend both days of your clinical site visit prior to the March 1 deadline A. Two consecutive 8-hour days, for a total of 16 hours B. Conservative business casual clothing required (no jeans, t-shirts, shorts, or tank tops) C. Closed-toe shoes required (no sandals or flip-flops) D. Must have and wear a white lab coat.

The most competitive applicants will be invited to continue the admissions process by participating in an entrance examination and personal interview with the Admission Committee.

Applicants are ranked based on:

- Clinical Site Visit Evaluation
- Completion of recommended courses
- Educational history (degree earned)
- Essay
- Interview
- Overall grade-point-average
- Performance on entrance examination
- Prerequisite grade-point-average
- Professional recommendations

Individuals that do not receive an invitation to continue with the admissions process are encouraged to address any deficiencies in their applications and reapply to the Radiation Therapy program in the future.
