### Required Prerequisite Courses for Admissions into Histotechnology

*Admissions for Fall 2018*

Applicants to the **one-year** program in Histotechnology must complete a minimum of 90 semester credit hours of the Texas Core Curriculum and prerequisite coursework. The courses may be taken at any regionally accredited college/university and must be completed prior to enrollment in the School of Health Professions.
